Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rosenberg at 7:30 A.M. in the Willson Board Room of Phoebe's Main Campus.

Open Meeting and Establish a Quorum:

Mr. Rosenberg welcomed the Authority and established that a quorum was present, with eight Members being in attendance. Mr. Rosenberg welcomed the two new Members of the Authority, Dr. Michael N. Laslie and Dr. Steven Kitchen.

Election of Officers for 2013:

Prior to proceeding with the other business of the meeting, a motion to re-elect Ralph Rosenberg as Chairman, Dr. Charles Lingle as Vice-Chairman, and Rev. Eugene Sherman as Secretary and elect Fred Ghiglieri as Assistant Secretary was made by Lamar Reese, seconded by John Hayes, and approved by all Members present. Mr. Rosenberg continued to preside at the meeting.

Approval of the Agenda:

The proposed Agenda was reviewed and a motion was made by Dr. Lingle and seconded by Fred Ghiglieri, to adopt the Agenda as presented. The motion was approved by all Authority Members in attendance.

Approval of the Minutes:

The proposed Minutes of the November 30, 2012 meeting had been provided to the Members prior to the meeting and the same was considered for approval. Dr. Lingle made a motion, seconded by Dr. Sherman to approve the Minutes as previously provided. The motion passed unanimously.

Overview of DNV Hospital Accreditation:

Joe Austin, Chief operating Officer for Phoebe Putney Health System made a presentation on the decision to use DNV rather than the Joint Commission in connection with the accreditation of the Hospital. Mr. Austin spoke in detail about the ensuing site visit and the preliminary report back to Phoebe. He spoke to the thoroughness of the matters that were surveyed and investigated as well as the constructive focus of DNV to help make the Hospital better in any areas it identified as needing improvement. Mr. Austin stated the DNV Accreditation team will make site visits once a year instead of every three years, as the Joint Commission did. A total of fifteen surveyors from DNV made a total of twenty findings at the main campus, none of which would require the DNV to make another visit within thirty days. A final report is expected from DNV surveyors by early next week and will be available to Authority members.

Financial Reports for Authority and for Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital:

Kerry Loudermilk, Chief Financial Officer for Phoebe, presented the financial statements of the Authority for January, 2013 and for year to date through January 2013. Questions and discussion followed. A motion was made by Dr. Lingle and seconded by Lamar Reese, to approve and accept the Financial Statements of the Authority as presented. Likewise, Mr. Loudermilk made a presentation of interim unaudited financial statements for Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital, Inc. Copies of the reports attached.

Phoebe Foundation/Update Report

Lauren Ray gave a presentation regarding the promotion and facilitation of charitable giving in support of Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. A copy of her presentation is attached. Mr. Wernick followed with some additional comments and observations concerning this component of financial support for the Hospital.

Closing of the Meeting:

A motion was made by Fred Ghiglieri and seconded by Dr. Sherman to close the meeting in order to engage in privileged consultation with legal counsel and to discuss potentially valuable commercial plans, proposals or strategy that may be of competitive advantage in the operation of Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital or its medical facilities, and to discuss confidential matters or information pertaining to peer review or provided by a review organization.




