Mr. Sullivan also introduced Maureen Jackson, a long time valuable employee of the Hospital and current Vice President, Surgical/Medical Services. Ms. Jackson provided additional information principally dealing with steps taken to provide upgraded patient care and safety. Copies of portions of reports attached.

Mr. Wernick provided comments, including tying in the concepts for the hoped for eventual development of Phoebe North.

Mr. Joe Austin followed with a presentation on overall operations and projects of interest as included in the attached presentations.

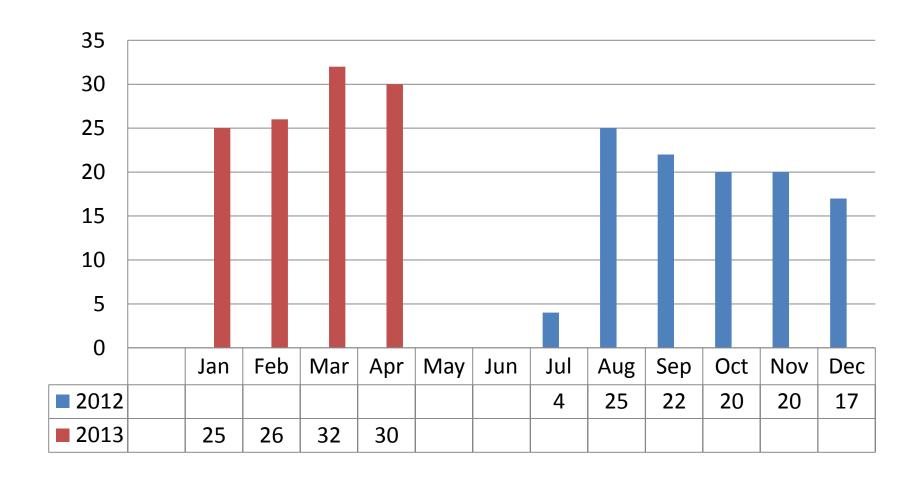
