## Open Meeting and Establish a Quorum:

## Temporary Easements at Phoebe North Campus (Palmyra Road) for City of Albany Sidewalk Project:

Tommy Coleman reported the City of Albany is requesting the Authority grant a temporary construction easement to the City of Albany on the properties known as 1950 Palmyra Road and 2000 Palmyra Road. Mr. Coleman further explained that the City owns the first 10-13 feet of property where the sidewalks are to be constructed and requests the temporary easement to allow construction equipment on Authority property. Mr. Coleman handed out copies of two resolutions along with copies of the City's Temporary Construction Easements for both properties for the Authority Members to review.

After discussion and questions, Clinton Johnson made a motion and Ferrell Moultrie seconded the motion, to approve the conveyance of a temporary construction easement from the Hospital Authority of Albany-Dougherty County to the City of Albany and authorizing the Chair to execute said easement for the property located at 2000 Palmyra Road. The motion passed unanimously by vote of all Members. A copy of the executed Resolution is attached to these minutes.

Ferrell Moultrie made a motion and Clinton Johnson seconded the motion, to approve the conveyance of a temporary construction easement from the Hospital Authority of Albany-Dougherty County to the City of Albany and authorizing the Chair to execute said easement for the property located at 1950

Palmyra Road. The motion passed unanimously by vote of all Members. A copy of the executed Resolution is attached to these minutes.

STATE OF GEORGIA } TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION COUNTY OF DOUGHERTY } EASEMENT

That in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00)s and other good and valuable consideration paid to HOSPITAL AUTHORITY OF ALBANY-DOUGHERTY COUNTY, GEORGIA, of the County of Dougherty, State of Georgia, as party of the first part, hereinafter called Grantor, by THE CITY OF ALBANY, GEORGIA, a municipal corporation, as party of the second part, hereinafter called Grantee (the words "Grantor" and "Grantee" to include their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns where the context requires or permits, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer and convey unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns a Temporary Access and Construction Easement. The Temporary Easement premises shall be used by the Grantee for the purpose of access to and construction of public utility improvements in association with sidewalk improvements, and is more particularly described as follows:

Being a ten-foot wide strip of land along the western property line and adjacent to the eighty foot wide right-of-way of Palmyra Road for a total distance of about six-hundred and eighty five feet, the area of described strip being six-thousand eight-hundred and fifty square feet, and as depicted on the attached sketch titled, EXHIBIT 'A' – 2000 PALMYRA ROAD, GRADING AND UTILITY EASEMENT & TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT, SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS, dated 07/10/2018, by the City of Albany Engineering Department.

The Grantee covenants to maintain the easement in good repair and efficiency so that no unreasonable damage will result from its use to the adjacent land of the Grantor, its successors and assigns.

The Grantor hereby covenants and warrants that Grantor owns the said land described herein and the undersigned, as or on behalf of Grantor, has the right to grant this temporary easement.

This temporary construction easement is in response to the City of Albany's sidewalk and street improvements for Palmyra Road. Grantor agrees that the City of Albany may grade, slope and improve the subject real property. This Temporary Access & Construction Easement shall expire one year from the date of execution or upon completion of the public utility construction, whichever occurs first.



The Temporary Easement premises shall be used by the Grantee for the purpose of access to and construction of public utility improvements in association with sidewalk improvements, and is more particularly described as follows:
